

The durability and water-resistant surfaces of luxury vinyl tile means your program's maintenance plan does not need to be complicated. The key is to keep the steps simple and consistent. Following this simple maintenance plan will keep your luxury vinyl floors looking clean and new.

ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

Dry Soil Removal

- Sweep up with a floor brush or soft-bristled broom. For more stubborn agents, use a cotton or microfiber towel.

Wet Cleaning

- Before wet cleaning, always remove dry soil (per the steps above).
- Damp mop the floor with a neutral cleaning solution. Harsh cleaning agents should not be used.
- Once complete, rinse the floors with clean warm water using a damp microfiber mop. It is important that water is not poured directly onto the floor.
- Allow floor to completely dry before introducing foot traffic.

PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

Walk Off Carpet / Mats

- Place walk-off mats at entrances and exits to minimize tracking in dirt, grit, chemicals, and corrosive elements. This will help provide an extra layer of protection and will make cleaning much easier and predictable.

Precautions

- When moving furniture and other heavy objects, always lift and carry. Do not drag or push across LVT floors.
- For fixed appliances and furniture, use non staining floor pads and protectors to disperse the weight evenly.

BEST PRACTICES

- Spot cleaning – Timing is important. For wet spills, use a towel to absorb the moisture, and if needed, a neutral cleaner to remove any residue.
- Do not use steel wool pads, stiff metal-bristled brushes, powdered cleaners, or overly acidic or alkaline cleaners.
- Avoid exposure to direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time.
